FORMAL NOTICE OF CONSULTATION ON THE REGULATION 14 STAGE OF SEEND PARISH NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN.

In accordance with the requirements of Paragraph 1 of schedule 1 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, I am writing to let you know that Seend Neighbourhood Development Plan will be out for Regulation 14 Consultation from Saturday 15th February 2020 until Saturday 28th March 2020 for a period of 6 weeks.

This Formal Consultation stage will be launched at an event on Saturday 15th February 2020 in The Irene Usher Memorial Hall (The Pavilion), Rusty Lane, Seend SN12 6NS between 10.30am and 1.30pm.
